

NOTICE

The Jarratt Town Council voted unanimously Tuesday July 28, 2019 that all trash put to the curb to be picked up by the Town of Jarratt employees must be in a trash can beginning August 04, 2020.

These are the guidelines for your trash to be collected by our public works employees:

- All trash MUST be in a trash can
- The trash can and contents should weigh no more than 50 pounds
- The Town Personnel are not allowed to enter buildings for removal of trash and/or garbage
- We will not collect trash that is left at the curb in only bags – it MUST be in a trash can
- All trash MUST be in a bag inside of the trash can – tied securely.

We will not collect waste matter discarded by contractors and/or tenants/landowners on building projects (old or new) and the burden of such waste matter shall be left to the property owner and/or tenant.

We do not pick up whole trees or big limbs.
